



Below→Faculties addressing the students

FLYING SIMULATION LAB- A REPORT

The **Department of Aviation Management** has taken special efforts for a practical visit to flying simulation lab at **St. Francis College,** Koramangala, on **19-06-2023**to make the students to know about the processes involved in **Boarding** an aircraft and the **Facilities** that are provided inside an aircraft.

The visiting team was introduced by the **Principal**, **St. Francis College**, to **Ms. Nethra**, Assistant Professor and HOD BBA A& BBAAVM, St. Francis College. The team was taken to the **Simulation Lab**.

The students and the accompanying faculty members were taken inside the aircraft, which had a seating capacity of **54 seats** and a briefing was done.

- a) Boarding Process involved such as:
 - 1. Screening & Security Check- Metal Detector at the entrance of the Lab
 - 2. Baggage Scanner
- b) Facilities provided inside an aircraft such as:
 - 3. Keeping of hand bags in a small compartment right above each passenger's seat.
 - 4. Fastening of the seat belt when the aircraft is taking off / landing.
 - 5. Adjusting of Air conditioner and dim-light according to the need by every passenger themselves.
 - 6. Announcement/s by the Pilot over the microphone that every passenger can hear through the small loudspeaker, fitted along with the air-conditioner and dim-light bulbs above their seats.
 - 7. Serving Trolley of food items, magazines and newspapers
 - 8. Separate Toilet facilities for passengers and cabin crew
- c) Cockpit Cabin Crew

Outside the aircraft the following amenities are provided:

(i) Restaurant

(ii) Currency Exchange Counter

The ceiling of Simulation Lab is done in the shape of aircrafts and the lighting facility is done near each aircraft on the ceiling.

Two Faculties namely (i) Mr. D.N. Kumar, Asst. Professor & H.O.D. and (ii) Mr. K. Gunashekar, Asst. Professor, Department of Aviation Management accompanied the students of II, IV and VI SEM BBA Aviation Management as detailed below:

- 1) II Sem 05 students
- 2) IV Sem -10 students
- 3) VI Sem 01student

Mr. D.N. Kumar and Mr. K. Gunashekar, Assistant Professor, IIMS also briefed the students about the etiquettes to be followed by passenger/s while travelling in an aircraft, including the importance of Fastening the seat belt when the aircraft is taking off / landing.

The students also got to know an opportunity, about the practical aspects of different aircrafts, aviation, career options, etc., in the aviation industry.

The students got a real-life exposure to the airport formalities and experience of air-travel and in-sight of an aircraft by the visit to Simulation Lab.

The Aircraft is named at Air-Francisian and a group photo was taken in front of the Aircraft.
